5TH ANNUAL WILDFLOWER WALK & CELEBRATION AT AWBREY PARK

The 5th Annual Wildflower Walk at Awbrey Park will be Saturday, April 16th, from 11:00 AM until 2:00 PM. Take a self guided tour or let one of the Friends of Awbrey Park lead you. You'll learn about the many native plants uncovered over the past eight years by volunteers. These plants are a perfect match for the soil and climate of the region and you may want to consider them for your landscape. Other activities include Frisbee golf, marshmallow roasting, s'mores making, horseshoes and a treasure hunt to find native plants with the possibility of taking one home.

The highlight of the day will be a ribbon cutting ceremony at noon for the new bridge. The bridge has opened up a forested area, contrasting nicely with the open fields of the main portion of the park. The bridge provides much safer access to the park for residents to the east. Neighbors can now enter the park via a new path off Calumet Circle.

Drop by anytime between 11:00 AM and 2:00 PM, April 16th; or just come for the ribbon cutting at noon.
